Applications for the inaugural WAMSS Community Development Bursary are now open!

Ever wanted to run a local fundraising event, hold an information evening, engage your local community in a volunteering initiative, or organise on a fun social occasion for your neighbours, friends and family?

If YES, then WAMSS wants to hear from you. WAMSS is putting out the call for all UWA medical students who want to engage in activities and organise events that will benefit the local community, so that the first Community Development Bursary can be awarded.

To apply for the bursary applicants must:

- Ensure that the grant money provided is spent on the event
- Demonstrate plans to engage in activities aimed at community development. Examples include those listed above.
- Submit a budget for the proposed event and provide the WAMSS Treasurer with all receipts following the completion of the event. Questions regarding budget writing can be emailed to treasurer@wamss.org.au
- Acknowledge the support of WAMSS in the advertising, promotion and during the community event.
- Sign a memorandum of understanding acknowledging their receipt of monies, their responsibility to WAMSS and to appreciate that they have no legal responsibility to repay the funds.
- Provide a brief report on the experience to the WAMSS Committee.
